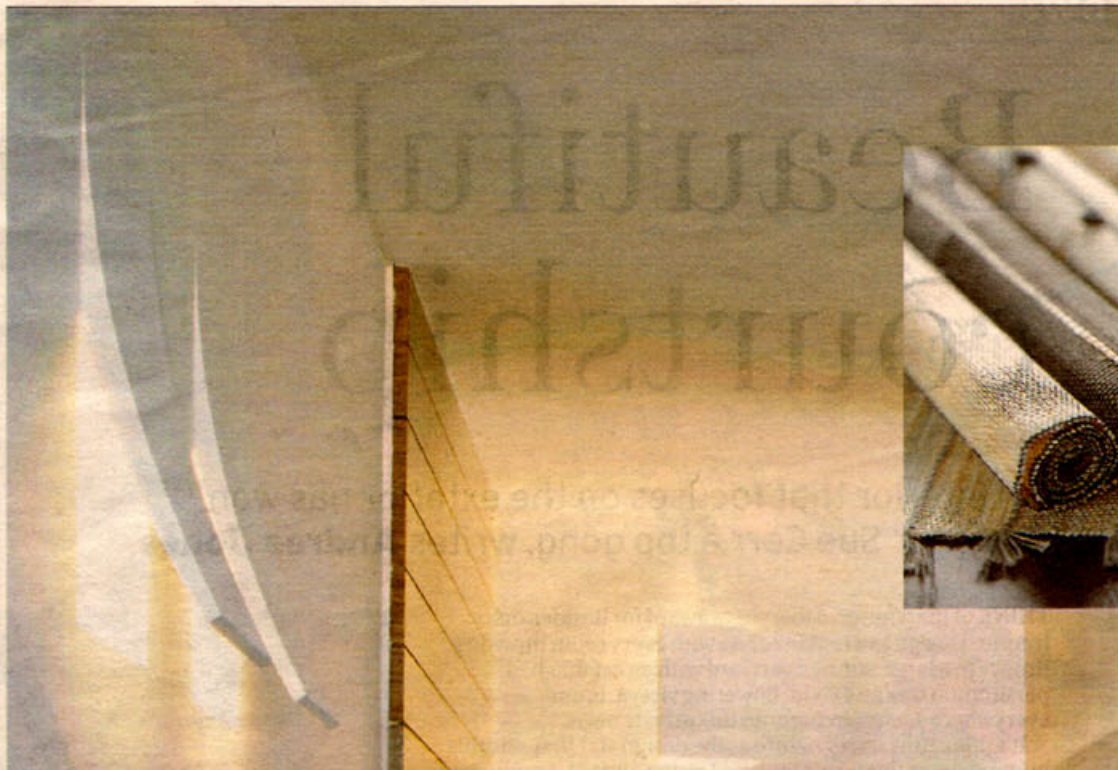

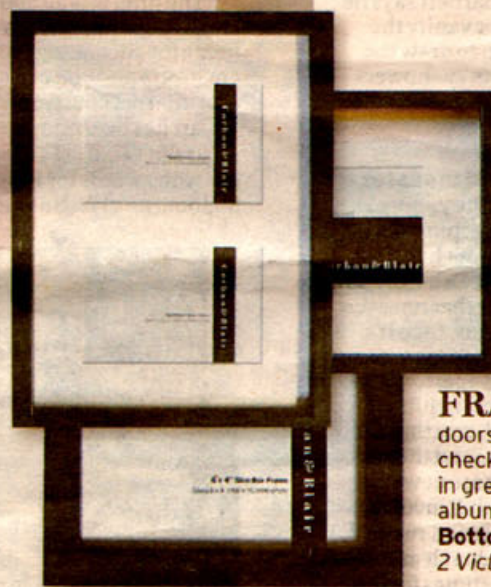
STOP PRESS
